#### **CENTS-ABILITY**

Cents-Ability originated in 1976 as "Two-Cents-A-Meal", a project inspired by Rosellyn Calvert in prayer and begun by Presbyterian Women to involve individuals and families in a corporate response to world hunger. Over the years, presbyteries have developed similar programs with a variety of names. Many of these programs benefit local hunger ministries as well as the national and international projects of the Presbyterian Hunger Program (PHP).

The PHP works to alleviate hunger and eliminate its causes. The PHP offers a means for also responding to the crisis of hunger in the United States and around the world in ways that impact the root causes of hunger and poverty. PHP addresses hunger holistically using five tools:

- Direct Food Relief combined with Root Cause Work
- Sustainable Development
- Advocacy
- · Intentional and sustainable living
- Education

Employing these tools alongside congregations, partners, and local communities, together we can help end hunger.

Here at DMPC, our Men of the Church have supported the meaningful work of Cents-Ability for many years by collecting donations in food cans placed on the tables during their monthly buckwheat feeds.
