


SEPTEMBER 8, 2024

NOTES FROM THE AUGUST 2024 SESSION MEETING...

At its August 12th meeting, Session attended to the following items:

- * Heard Elder Monica Varchetto offer a devotional shared from the Perch Church in Glendale, California, "People Plan and God Sits Back and Laughs", followed by prayer.
- * Approved Corrected Minutes from the stated meeting on July 8, 2024. Approved minutes are on the hallway bulletin board or available by request from the clerk. No one responded to the request for a Ruling Elder Commissioner to attend the Presbytery of West Virginia Stated Meeting on Saturday, August 17, in Huntington. Received a letter from PC(USA) Office of Ministry Engagement and Support thanking us for our submission of \$256.67 in Mission Support, \$119.40 in Pentecost Offering and \$38.81 for Cents-Ability.

Received a letter of appreciation for our \$500 financial support of the D&E Presbyterian Scholars Program.

Received a letter of thanks from Tyrand Cooperative Ministries for our \$1,000 financial support of their 2023 Thanksgiving Basket Ministry.

- * Welcomed Elder Robert M^CCutcheon, from the Christian Education Committee, who spoke of early plans for a "Reformation and The Bible" Bread & Broth Study, on Wednesdays this fall, and a Lay Academy series on MacBeth, taking place on Monday evenings.
- * Received a report from Jane Hazer, HTLC representative. They are excited to host the town hall meeting on September 10th, at 5:30 (sic).
- * Received a report from Transition Team Co-Chairperson Sherri Marstiller, discussing the low number of survey responses and the committee making follow-up phone calls. Team members are also inviting everyone to participate in the town hall meetings planned for September. A retreat to present the Mission Study Report is tentatively planned for October 19.
- * Rev. Moore invited everyone to the Installation Ceremony of D&E Benfield-Vick Chaplain, Franklin Tanner Capps, Th.D. at Robbins Memorial Chapel, Sunday, Aug. 25, at 4:00pm. He encourages us to wear red for the ceremony.
- * Approved an invitation to Dumitru Roibu, Executive President of YMCA Moldova, serving as an International Peacemaker to D&E, to preach in both churches on September 15.
- * Finance Accepted financial reports; reports are available from the treasurer upon request. We haven't needed a transfer from the Angel Fund yet this year. Committees were requested to plan and submit their 2025 budgets at the September meeting.
- * Property The kitchen restoration is on schedule: cabinets are back in, heatproof wall tiles will go in, then the gas range. Countertops need replacing.
 We are seeking quotes for new flooring in the Fellowship Hall and the current contractor replacing drywall, ceiling tiles and lights hopes to start the first week of September.
 The stonework and railings are back in the Memory Garden.

A diseased tree was recently removed from the front lawn of Manse 2. There are water leaks in the roof, gutters and a cast iron stack going through all levels of the house.

- * Worship To date, Worship expenses are \$13,040.65. Communion servers in July were Sue Chenoweth, Mina Cupp, Linda Rudy and Cliff Marstiller. Thank you! The committee also thanks Julia Elbon, Phil Becker, Sue Chenoweth and Sherri Marstiller for serving as liturgists!
- * Witness and Service A Mobile Food Pantry Truck is scheduled for Saturday, September 7; those who plan to help should report to Church Lane at 10:00.
- * Since the Chaplains from the Lutheran Campus Ministry of WVU will be here to preach on October 26, session accepted a committee recommendation to have a special offering in support of that ministry on that day.
- * Christian Education Rally Day is set for September 8, 2024.
 There is D&E Student Orientation on Monday, August 19th, at the Madden Center.
 Bob M^CCutcheon will be there.
- * Fellowship A hotdog party is in planning, possibly for Rally Day.

Transition Team and Mission Study Update Planning Our Future Together

Davis Memorial Presbyterian Church (DMPC) and Holy Trinity Lutheran Church (HTLC) have entered into a time of discernment during which your Transition Team is gathering information to guide our decisions for our future. One of these information gathering tools was the Congregational Assessment Tool (CAT) survey which was sent out to everyone in late July. We wish to sincerely thank all those who took the time to complete the survey.

The time frame for survey completion has ended and the results are being reviewed and compiled by the experts at Holy Cow! Consulting. The results will be presented to your Transition Team in early September. This presentation, along with results from our "town hall" discussion groups will be used to create the Mission Study report. Once approved by Session and the Committee on Ministry, this report will be presented to the congregations of both churches at a retreat to be scheduled in October (tentatively October 19).

Team members have been notifying everyone of the dates of the group discussions that will take place the week of September 9th. There are four sessions planned at DMPC and one at HTLC with Pastor T. Wes moderating each one. If you have not been advised of a date and are interested in participating, please notify Sherri Marstiller (treasurer@dmpc.org) or Lynn Proudfoot (clerk@dmpc.org) and we will get you scheduled. Your input is invaluable to the mission study process. We hope you will join us.

Be assured that this Mission Study is an important and required step leading to the appointment of your Pastor Nominating Committee and the search for our new Installed Pastor.


One Last thing! Brenda when you clean the church would you PLEASE get rid of the cobweb up by the organ, it is driving me crazy.
